Welcome to the Little Free Library. This library belongs to everyone, your neighbors, friends and people who pass by. Anyone may use it. This little Free Library offers a way to share good things to read while promoting a sense of community and literacy

Little Free Library was started in 2009 in Hudson, Wisconsin by Todd Bol as a tribute to his mother, who was a teacher and lover of books. He and a friend became inspired by their community gift giving and saw the potential to reach a greater good.
